High Point Theatre Production Brings New Life to “It’s a Wonderful Life”

Live performance of heartwarming Holiday classic sets the mood for a season of joy.

High Point, North Carolina, November 30, 2009 – For many of us, the holiday season just isn't complete until we have revisited the fictional town Bedford Falls and heard again the remarkable tale of one George Bailey. The man who discovers the incredible value of his seemingly insignificant life as he experiences what the world might have been without him, speaks clearly and powerfully of each individual's inestimable worth.

This year, fans of this marvelous story have a unique opportunity to relive it in a whole new way. Celebrating the holiday season, the High Point Theatre presents playwright Joe Landy's inspired reinterpretation of the classic Frank Capra film in a special, must-see, one night only performance.

“It’s a Wonderful Life: Live from WVL Radio Theatre” takes us back to George Bailey's day through a recreation of that era's most popular medium. Since its initial performance in 1996, “It’s a Wonderful Life: Live from WVL Radio Theatre” has become a tradition in cities such as Chicago, Los Angeles and Toronto, as well as small towns throughout America. Recalling the power of this tale, one Asheville area audience member said, “When it ended, I sat there ... moved to tears, my heart wide open ... flooded with gratitude for all the blessings in my life.” Heralded as “one of the best holiday shows around” by the Chicago Tribune, this fresh twist on a true classic makes its Triad debut at the High Point Theatre on Tuesday, December 22.
